Daffodil Days Sunday of Hope

A special memorial program for churches.



The Basic Concept

- Church members are given the opportunity to provide daffodils in memory of or in honor of special individuals in exchange for a donation to the American Cancer Society.
- Donation: \$10 per bunch of ten flowers or \$10 for a potted plant of 3-4 blooming bulbs.
- The daffodils are used to decorate the church on Daffodil Sunday, March 25, 2007.
- Following the event, the flowers are given to people in the congregation or taken home by the donor.

Organization of Daffodil Sunday of Hope

- Daffodil Sunday of Hope is arranged and coordinated by a church member
- This person will be responsible for promoting the event through church bulletins or newsletters, processing the daffodil orders to the American Cancer Society, and collecting the donations
- The morning of Daffodil Sunday of Hope the sanctuary is decorated with the memorial daffodils
- The service is planned with "HOPE" as the theme
- The sermon and music all signify hope with the flowers as a reminder
- A cancer education message may be included in the church bulletin along with a listing of donors
- Designate one representative from your church to take care of the orders
- Complete and return the enclosed Daffodil Days Order Form by March 2, 2007.
- Flowers will be delivered on Friday, March 23, 2007
